The KCK Police Department also offers Tuition Assistance in the form of reimbursement.

Associate's Degree - \$60/Credit Hour Bachelor's Degree - \$85/Credit Hour Master's Degree - \$110/Credit Hour

Compensation Example: A 6 year officer with a Bachelor's Degree would be compensated with an annual salary of \$74,284.68. This Officer would also receive an extra \$125/month for their degree, and an additional \$46.03/month for their longevity. That would bring their total compensation for the year to \$76,337.04 or \$36.70/hour.

In addition to 11 paid holidays, employees can also work overtime for compensatory time rather than overtime payment. An employee's compensatory bank can contain as much as 200 hours of time. This time can be used to take a day(s) off at the employees discretion, manpower permitting.
